The international conference "Urban Maintenance as strategy for sustainable development" follows the other two international conferences "Informatic tools for built management" held in 1999 and 2000 by the Dipartimento di Configurazione e Attuazione dell'Architettura.

The basic cultural aim is in both cases the assumption of the maintenance as a strategic factor for future urban development. So far the first goal of the conference will be the mint of a direct comparison between the updated and ripe research sector and the urban maintenance operators.

Thus a number of representative of well known Institutions managing built heritage at urban scale will be invited.

At the conference main results of national and international research on Urban Maintenance will be outlined and papers will be published in the Conference Proceedings, while presented during the conference sessions.

Moreover the evolution of Informatic Systems as tools for management and maintenance actors will be developed, towards both built heritage and urban service networks.

Financial operators involved in urban maintenance will also carry their contribution.

Call for papers

Papers are invited on the topic outlined and others falling within the aim of the meeting. Abstracts less than 300 words should be submitted to the conference secretariat no later than **July the 10th 2002.**

Full papers should be submitted no later than 15th September 2002.

Abstract should clearly state purposes, results and conclusions of the work to be described in the final paper. First acceptance will be noticed before July the 30th 2002, final acceptance will be based on the full paper and it will be noticed before October the 15th 2002.

It will also be notified whether the paper should be described by means of oral or poster presentation at the conference.

Each submitted paper is subject to a separate registration. We strongly encourage the submission of abstracts electronically.

Abstracts must be submitted in English.

Papers can be in Italian or in English.
