

Do you have a brilliant LED project or solution? Make it shine!

1. THE CODEGA PRIZE

The Codega Prize is the recognition of the excellences of LED lighting and is assigned to the best solutions/realizations for:

- their innovative aspects
- the use of smart lighting
- the results of energy saving & efficiency

The Prize is assigned for the quality and know-how in transforming technology in new ideas and it is related to **Contract/Commercial*** applications only. The Codega Prize aims at spreading the culture of light and the related aspects of energy saving, creativity and quality which are linked to Solid State Lighting.

The Prize is promoted and organized by **Assodel** (Italian Association of Electronics Suppliers) in partnership with **IDEA** (International Distribution of Electronics Association) and under the patronage of **APIL** (Italian Association of Lighting Professionals)

* According to the DOE – US Department of Energy, LED applications can be divided into 4 categories: Residential, Commercial, Industrial, Outdoor/Urban. In the Commercial area, the classification concerns Hospitality, Retail, Food, Offices, Social, Schools etc.

2. ADMISSION CRITERIA AND CATEGORIES

Category 1 – Lighting Design

Prize to the best lighting design project/installation in Contract/ Commercial lighting

- the participation to the Prize is free of charge and it is opened exclusively to independent lighting designers and lighting professionals (technical offices of companies or lighting distribution companies are excluded);
- the solutions and works presented have to refer to a period of realization included between 1st July 2015 and 30th August 2016;
- each participant can present up to 3 projects/works.

Category 2 – LED Solutions

Prize to the best LED lighting product (system, luminaire or solution)

- the participation to the Prize is free of charge and it is opened to lighting companies and professionals;
- each participant can present up to 3 projects/works.

3. SUBSCRIPTION

Contestants must submit their projects and solutions, within 12.09.16. The registration for the awards and the submitting of necessary documents required for participation is free of charge and has to be made according to the following process:

 Register as a contestant, by selecting the category in which you want to participate, completing the application form in all its parts, including the "Project description"

3. Send the application form (filled in and signed) together with some pictures (Maximum 5 Images) and technical sheets (Maximum 5 charts in A3 – pdf format*) to by the 12th September 2016
4. Repeat the process if you want to submit more projects (Maximum 3 Projects)

2. EVALUATION CRITERIA

The projects/realizations must incorporate innovation and sustainability elements.

They evaluation criteria will take into account their innovative aspect, the Composition (of the adopted solutions), Energy efficiency and Energy saving results.

* Send an application form for each submitted project or product

** As attachment, the following documents are accepted: **pdf** of the project on **horizontally read DIN A3**

sheet, that includes the **datasheet** (Maximum 5 documents explaining the concept and the technical aspects). The jury will take into consideration if contestants accompany the sheet submittal with videos, 3D rendering or other multimedia support. We suggest to use we transfer service to send the selected material.

***By submitting info and pictures you are agreeing to their dissemination in partner publications and online.

5. COMMITEE

The Prize is assigned by a **Committee** of 9 members nominated by Assodel among the institutions, Universities and associations linked to the lighting sector. The composition of the Jury is published on www.codegaprize.com. The members of the Committee cannot take part to the Codega Prize contest. Each member has one vote. The Committee assigns the prize through an evaluation which is taken by members via e-mail on the basis of the documents handed out by each participant. The Committee will keep the nominations and winner secret until the Codega Prize ceremony.

6. PRIZE GIVING

The Codega will nominate a first prize winner for each category and will possibly select up to two special mentions as well.

Winners will be announced at **ILLUMINOTRONICA** (Padua, 6/8th Oct.), the unique trade fair devoted to Solid State Lighting. The prize giving will take place on **Friday 7th October** in Venice.

7. PROMOTION

The Codega Prize and its winner and nominees will be published on after the Codega ceremony and on <u>www.ledlab.net</u>. The vote will be taken into consideration by the Jury for possible mentions/special recognitions.

The projects will also be promoted on the web and magazines linked to the event and in a series of initiatives.

9. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Each participant allows the Secretary to reproduce the work/project rights in all the promotional tools linked to the event

- Each participant allows the Secretary to use his/her personal data, which will be handed out according to 675/96 L. (*Privacy law*) and its modifications. D.lgs. 196/2003 (*Privacy Code*).

- Material, documents and works linked to the Codega candidacy will remain property of Assodel and/or of the Codega Secretary

- Entrants giving false or misleading information will be excluded from the competition.

- Entrants agree to attend at their own expenses the prizes ceremony in Venice on 7th October 2016. If none is available for whatever reason, the organizers reserve the right to nominate a collector on his/her behalf.

- The participation to the Codega Prize implies the acceptance of all the rules of this document.
