



TERMS OF COMPETITION

Concept

The international design competition COOK8 has as its subject the design of an interior dining space for 8 people, of an area of 24 - 30m².

The aim of the competition is the formulation of new ideas on the design of a meeting-place for people on the occasion of the preparation and consumption of food, seen as means of socialisation. What is looked for is the creative re-interpretation and overtaking of the usual approaches which are a function of the conventional building and management arrangements of catering premises (private or communal dining-room, club, commercial restaurant, café, cafeteria, snack-bar, fast food outlet, taverna, canteen, etc.).

The three awarded entries will be realised in full scale (1: 1) at the Benaki Museum.

Specifications

The space must include:

- A preparation area (conservation, readying, preparation, cleaning, storage of foodstuffs and utensils)
- A consumption area
- A hygiene area (WC and washbasin, together or separate).

The outline of the room in the ground plan and section will be determined by the competitors in such a way that it will contain a net area of the ground plan of 24 - 30m². The available height is 3.20m (from floor to ceiling in the bearing structure).

Access to the space is by an entrance. The space must be clearly delineated by perimeter walls in which, apart from the entrance, there is at least one aperture (door or window) to the exterior. The design of any open-air or outside area, roofed or otherwise, is not included in the objects of the competition.

The interior must include the three above-mentioned areas for preparation, consumption, and hygiene, appropriately designed on the criteria of the creative authenticity of the competitors.

The three awarded entries will be realised as exhibits. There will be no water supply nor drainage, therefore these areas are also not included in the objects of the competition.

Organisation and co-ordination of the competition

Qualification for participation

Everyone engaged in creativity, whether individually or in the form of a company, or in teams of natural or legal persons, who are active in the fields of architectural design, interior design, the composition of art installations, stage set design, decoration and related activities are qualified to enter the competition. Those with a connection with the organisation or the writing of the competition documentation and those involved in the compilation or in the preparation of its programme are not qualified to take part directly or indirectly. Entrants must not receive direct or indirect support in relation to the competition from the above persons.

Valid Entry

There is no registration procedure for the competition. DOMÉS retains the right of publication, in whatever way, of the data to be submitted. The competitors retain the intellectual property rights over their work.

1. Ground plan of room (scale 1:33.3) orientated north - south
2. Unfolding of walls of main space of the room (scale: 1:33.3)
3. Two representations of the room (perspective, axonometric, etc.)
4. Text of up to 800 spaces in Greek or English.

OPTIONAL DATA AT THE DISCRETION OF THE DESIGNERS

5. Projection of ceiling of room (scale: 1:66.6)
6. Section of room (scale: 1:66.6)
7. Unfolding of walls of other spaces of the room (scale: 1:33.3)
8. More than two representations of the room (perspective, axonometric, etc.)
9. Other data

Anonymity

The anonymity of the entrants will be maintained throughout the competition and the awards procedure until the taking of the final decision by the Jury on the evaluation of the proposals. Anonymity will be lifted at the exhibition of the proposals. The publication of the proposals will also be by name.

Prizes and Distinctions

Three equal cash prizes of €2,000 will be awarded. Six commendations will also be made on the proposal of the Jury.

Exhibition of entries

In accordance with the COOK8 programme, all the entries, with names, will be exhibited in the Benaki Museum from 13/06/2018 - 31/07/2018.

The entries to which the three cash prizes are awarded will be constructed in the exhibition location on a 1:1 scale, with the collaboration of their creators. The cash prizes are intended as compensation for the work carried out on their part for the realisation of the designs within the context and for the duration of the exhibition.

For the realisation of the awarded entries, DOMÉS will secure the collaboration of leading producers and suppliers of building materials, equipment, and accessories. The intention of the organisers is the realisation of the three awarded entries in accordance with the wishes of their creators as these are formulated in their proposal, with the sole limitation being that the selection of the building materials, equipment, and accessories will be based on what the producers and suppliers have available.
