The building should be approximately 80 square meters, in one or more simple units. The project must include design of the buildings and outdoor space where the services can be located. The outdoor space should flow seamlessly with the **Social Club** building and with the city. The nature of the service and the public value of the Club should be clear in the project (there are no fences allowed).

Energy sustainability must be a key feature of the design and the programme. Projects submitted should include a passive, ecological and natural energy model that represents a positive paradigm for the rest of the city and an example of "best practices".



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
