Call for Abstract

In sight of the publication of the Proceedings of the Seminar, architects, musicians, scholars, experts and all who are interested in the relations between the two disciplines are invited to present *a paper abstract* on the subject "Music and Architecture". The abstracts shall be presented for selection in a **Word file (.doc) of 1500/2000 characters within the 15th January 2012** to the following electronic address: *musica_architettura@uniroma1.it*. The participants have to contextually notify personal data (name [required], profession, institution, telephone, fax, email [required]).

The authors of the <u>selected</u> abstracts have to produce the **full paper of 8/10.000 characters** within **30 days** from the selection notice (to be shown on http://w3.uniroma1.it/musiarch/). The full papers will be published in a special section of the Seminar Proceedings.

Call for Work (Design/Music)

In sight of the next edition of EMUfest 2012 (International Electroacoustic Music Festival – http://emufest.org), architects, musicians "under 45" who are interested in the relations between the two disciplines are invited to present a design/music work related to the conceptual and poetic sphere of "Music and Architecture: Composition, Space, Sign". The work will be jointly conceived and developed by integrated teams of architects and musicians (at least 1+1), in creative integration and symbiosis. The works will be presented in the typical forms of the architectural representation and of the musical works (for the musical section refer to the regulations of EMUfest http://emufest.org). The works are to be delivered on DVD, with a brief description of no more than 1000 characters (in English or Italian) printed on an A4 sheet, and the eventual musical score. The data of the authors' group (names [required]), title, any affiliation, phone, fax, e-mail [required]) must also be attached to the DVD. The DVD (that may include video, images and/or audio files), delivered by hand or by post, must be received by May 31st 2012 at "Dipartimento di Architectura e Progetto, via Flaminia 359, 00196 Roma". The object "Music and Architecture. Call for Work (Design / Music)" must be indicated on the package. The works selected among the received ones, will be presented in a special session of the Emufest 2012.
